## 11<sup>TH</sup> APRIL TO 22<sup>ND</sup> MAY 2020

Since the end of March 2020, our country is reeling under the Coronavirus outbreak. With nationwide lockdown and social distancing to help reduce the spread of the virus among the general population, citizens are facing multitude of problems. Vidya Bharati's alumni, schools and teachers have been working tirelessly across India during this time of distress and helping those in need.

Few of such instances has been highlighted below:

#### I. <u>Haryana Pranta:</u>



Food made for the families of laborers who are unemployed due to the shutdown because of Coronavirus by Haryana Vidya Mandir Sdhora.



Vidya Bharati alumni Kamal Bajaj distributed cooked food to the needy during the day and taught maths during the night through YouTube to students so that they do not fall back during the lock down period.



Vidya Bharati School Nand Lal Gita Vidya Mandir, Tepla, Haryana prepared and distributed 700 meals during the lock down.



Ration distributed to the needy people by Nand Lal Geeta Vidha Mandir Tepla Ambala.

विद्या भारती हरियाणा संगठन के अध्यक्ष डॉ. ऋषिराज वशिष्ठ ने नहीं हो पाए हैं लेकिन विद्या भारती के आचार्य, प्रबंध समितियां, पूर्व छात्र समाज सेवा में अहम भूमिका निभा रहे हैं। बताया कि हरियाणा में विद्या भारती की दो समितियां हिंद शिक्षा समिति कार्य कर रही हैं।

इन दोनों समितियां के अंतर्गत पूर्व छात्रों के सहयोग से 11593 मिला। 107635 भोजन के पैकेट.

1952 सेनिटाइजर, 8179 मास्क, 784 जगहों पर पशु चारा उपलब्ध करवाने के साथ 85 गांवों के लोगों को कोरोनावायरस के प्रति जागरूक कहा कि विद्या भारती शिक्षा के क्षेत्र किया। संगठन के आचार्यों व में अग्रणी संगठन है जो हरियाणा में पूर्व छात्रों ने 31,94,200 रुपए विभिन्न स्तर के 72 विद्यालयों का प्रधानमंत्री कोष एवं 4,41,100 संचालन कर रहा है। कोरोनावायरस रुपए मुख्यमंत्री कोष में जमा करवा के बंद के कारण विद्यालय आरंभ कर समाज के लिए एक मिसाल खडा करने का प्रयास किया। कहा कि विद्या भारती से जुड़े कार्यकर्ता घरों पर मास्क बनाकर जरूरतमंद लोगों तक पहुंचाने का प्रयास कर रहे हैं। श्री मद्भागवत गीता वरिष्ठ शिक्षा समिति एवं ग्रामीण विकास माध्यमिक विद्यालय कुरुक्षेत्र के पूर्व छात्रों द्वारा संचालित गीता रसोई 50 दिनों से लगातार जरूरतमंद काम करने वाले विद्यालयों के लोगों तक भोजन पहुंचा कर आचार्यों, प्रबंध समितियां एवं समाज में उदाहरण पेश कर रही है। इसके अतिरिक्त प्रचार विभाग पैकेट अनाज के वितरित किए द्वारा सोशल मीडिया के माध्यम से जिससे 11111 लोगों को सहयोग कोरोनावायरस से बचने के लिए अभियान भी चलाया जा रहा है।


Chairman of Sarvhitkari Vidya Mandir CBSE Bhikhi, sanitized his school and other schools in his area along with help of local administration.

## IV. Meerut Pranta:




NCC students of Meerut school organized public awareness campaigns related to pandemic and distributed face masks.

## जरूरतमंदो एवं असहायों को ५२५ भोजन पैकेट का किया वितरण





525 food packets were distributed to the needy during the lock down by alumni members in Dhikol village and Bora-Mangri village of Rajasthan.





Teachers, students, alumni and parents of S.V.M Sen. Sec. Sarni came together to distribute 1000 face masks.





Approximately 725 masks were distributed in Akhetpur (Dongri Tola) by Vidya Bharati alumni of Saraswati Higher Secondry School, Beohari.



Saraswati Shishu Parishad, Vidya Bharati Mahakoshal province decided to give their school buildings to be used as isolation centers during Covid 19 pandemic. Under this, 4799 rooms of 256 Shishu Mandirs and 1875 toilets, including 240 vehicles were assigned to this service.


