An Ideal Model of National Spirit in Vidya Bharati Education System - Yatindra Sharma

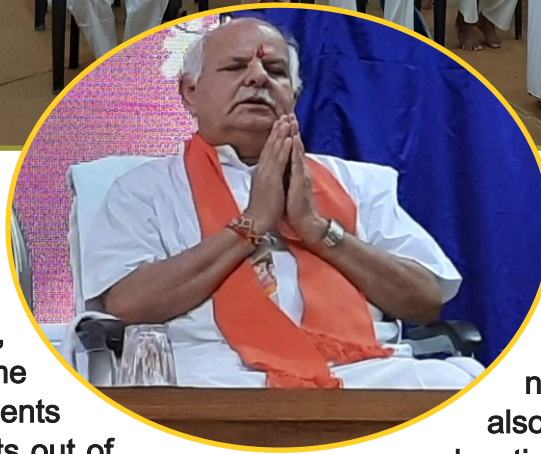


Speaking on the occasion, Joint Organising Secretary, Yatindra Sharma said that many useful innovations have taken place in the education sector in the dire circumstances of the Covid period. The teaching of students was kept smooth through E-Pathshala videos, etc., using innovative scientific techniques, through village Pathshala and Mohalla learning centers. To bring awareness among the family, society and nation help from the elder students and parents came forward.

Referring to the Vidya Bharati organization, Sharma ji said that Vidya Bharati, through its teachers, management committees and full-time workers, is teaching 34,47,856 students through 12,830 schools in 632 districts out of 711 districts of the country. Establishing an ideal model of national sentiment in the education system is our mission.

With a view to presenting the draft of the National Education Policy, in 1998, Vidya Bharati had given a report to the Central Government on the basis of the important points mentioned by the various Education Commissions constituted by the Central Governments in the past, demanding their implementation.

Vidya Bharati itself has been implementing these points since the very beginning, for all-around



development of the students, in its schools and to awaken the positive attitude of the students towards society and the nation. All these points have also been included in the new education policy announced by the Government last year.

This year is also being celebrated as the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', in order to introduce the citizens of the country to the freedom movement and the revolutionaries, sacrifices and great men who have been striving for it, to inculcate a sense of pride towards them. To join the celebrations Vidya Bharati has planned many programs throughout the year. There is also a plan to take large-scale cooperation of the academic councils, alumni and parents across the country in all these works.



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What should be the Nature of the Programs of Family Enlightenment – J M Kashipati



Sri J M Kashipati, Organising Secretary, held a special discussion with representatives from all over the country on family awareness, environmental protection, and social harmony activities. He emphasised that the Indian way of life should become a matter of conduct of families, how we can make a plastic-free society and how we can make it easy for all sections of society to interact with each other.

He said that arrangements should be made for the training of migrant workers in relation to these three so that they can monitor all the components of the school on migration. Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad

Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad is one of the 4 schools from Uttar Banga Pranta with a Madhyamik affiliation. The school which was developed brick by brick by the help of the local people, today, stands as a promise to hold the society united.

The Principal of Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad, Sri Bimal Chandra Das, mentioned, the school was started in 2001 with only primary sections. "Understanding the need of a school, which will not only impart quality education, but also act as institution for social change, we held a meeting in the year 2000 with the Karyakartas and Teachers of other schools", recalled Sri Das.

Soon a land of 8-10 bighas was rented and the 1st school building was erected which has fenced walls and tinned roof. The Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad, started functioning in 2001 and continued in this same building till 2007. "The number of students kept growing each year and we felt the need of a bigger school building", said Sri Das.

Soon a land of 8-10 bighas was rented and the 1st schIn 2008, 3 bigha lands were purchased and a new school building was constructed with bricked walls and tinned roof. Within a year the area was badly hit by a cyclone damaging the entire school building. "We had to reconstruct the school, for which we needed monetary support", mentioned Sri Bimal Das.

Sri Das, along with the teachers, chalked out a plan and presented it to ONGC. They also went door-to-door seeking for support. The entire society came together to help to their best capacity. Soon a donation from ONGC also reached them.

Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad received its Madhyamik affiliation in 2017. There are 65 teachers and around 1200 students currently studying in the school. While the old school building has 12 classrooms, the new building houses 30 classrooms, a library, separate toilet blocks, science lab and a sports ground. The construction work of a computer lab and a smart classroom is currently in progress. The school has also applied for Atal Tinkering Lab.

The school participates in various social activities involving the students. Every year food and clothes are distributed in the tribal villages surrounding the school. "There are around 20 to 25 tribal students in



our school who study here free of cost. Since language is a big problem for them, we also have a Tribal Teacher in our school, to help these students with their studies", mentioned Sri Das.

The school also has a strong alumni network. It is noteworthy to mention that 14 female alumni from the school are currently working in various district hospitals as nurses. Furthermore, during the Covid lockdown period last year, a number of alumni came together to raise funds and provide food and medicines to the needy people of the district for more than a month.

Sarada Vidya Mandir, Hemtabad stands as an ideal example where brain and heart come together to spread love and compassion.





Areca Raina, A Young Ayurvedic Doctor from Jammu Treating Patients In The Most Holistic Way

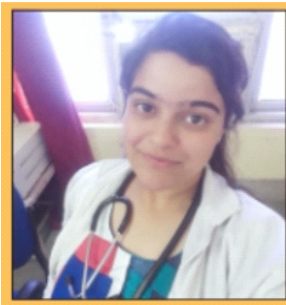
The Ayurvedic concept appeared and developed between 2500 and 500 BC in India. The literal meaning of Ayurveda is "science of life". One of the main beliefs is that the food we eat affects our overall wellbeing, and can make us elated or miserable. Essentially, we can be full of energy and vitality or lethargic and run-down based on what we put into our bodies. Ayurvedic practitioners often say that their patients can concentrate better, sleep better and feel less anxious overall.

Areca Raina, an alumna of Bhartiya Vidya Mandir, Ambphalla Jammu, where she only studied till class 2, is a young Ayurvedic doctor from Jammu. She completed the rest of her schooling from the Army school and then pursued her BMS (Bachelor of Medical Sciences) from Jammu.

"I have studied in the Vidya Bharati School from nursery till class 2. And these formation years have impacted my life deeply. I held the Indian culture so close to my heart that I choose to study Ayurvedic field of medicine", recalled Areca.

Those who have studied this field of medicine would agree to that fact that it is no less difficult a subject to study as is allopathic. In fact, Ayurveda is more difficult. "While Allopathic doctors would suggest paracetamol for fever, an Ayurvedic doctor would give Samshamani Vati. This medicine is formulated to treat all types of fever. It helps to strengthen the body's immune system and enhance the body's ability to fight against the various bacterial and viral infections. The good thing about any Ayurvedic medicine is that it does not have any side effect", mentioned Areca.

Areca, after completing her BMS, started to practice in private hospital in Jammu. She has treated several Covid patients. But she started the Covid treatment from her home by treating her mother who was suffering from fever and had mild cough. Once that remedy was successful, she started to offer the same treatment to the



patients who used to come to her with Covid symptoms. She helped to boost immunity followed by a strength treatment through Ayurvedic antibiotics for many people.

Here are some tips shared by Areca to fight the Covid battle:

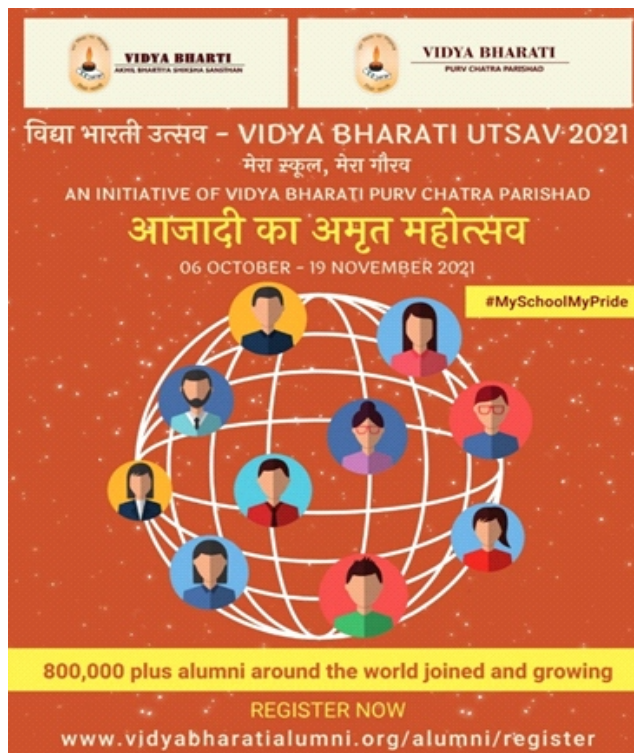
- Although humans are social beings but it is necessary to maintain personal hygiene and social distancing
- Wear mask whenever you are going outside your home
- One has to be a little selfish for one's sake. If you don't get infected by Covid, then your family will also be safe
- Take Vitamin C supplements, citrus fruits and chavanprash
- Take ayurvedic medicines such as Guduchi Satva and Triphala
- Make kadha at home and have it every day in the morning as you wake up and before going to bed
- Black coffee or green tea can be also taken if you have cold
- Lakshmi Vilas Ras can be taken to cure phlegm and respiratory related disorders such as cough, cold and asthma

• Tribhuvan Kirti Ras provides immediate relief from cough, body aches, cold and fever

• Lavangadi vati can be taken for treating upper respiratory infections like cough, congestion, cold

• Sitopaladi churna and Talisadi Churna are very effective for whooping cough, sore throat, cold, asthma, bronchitis

With the enormous knowledge of nature-based medicine, the relationship of human body constitution and function to nature and the elements of the universe that act in coordination and affect the living beings, Ayurvedic system will continue to flourish in ages still to come.

"I felt that the knowledge and moral that I have acquired from my school, I should transfer that knowledge to the children. So I started teaching in Shishu Mandir while I was doing my graduation", mentioned Garima.

Right after completing her graduation, Garima joined The Hunger Project as a Field Trainer, which runs in 6 states of India including Uttarakhand.

"The project focuses on two things – health and education of the people living in rural areas", mentioned Garima. Currently, 66-gram panchayats are included under this project. Garima meets the Sarpanch and Block Officers and explains to them about various government schemes which can benefit people. She then organizes a meeting with the villagers to help them understand about these schemes.

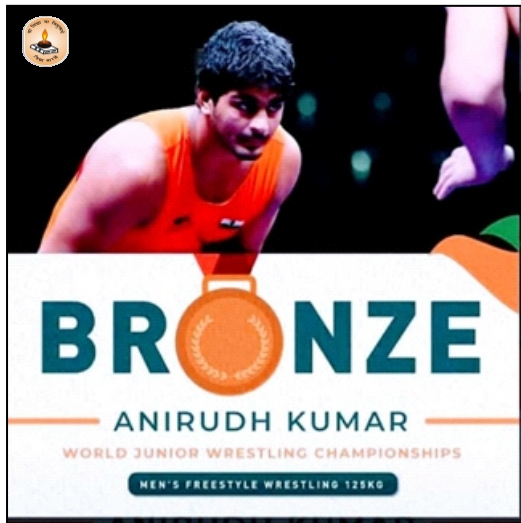


Congratulations to Vidya Bharati alumni Nishad Kumar on winning the silver medal at the Tokyo Paralympics.
