Vidya Bharati alumni and Tokyo Paralympics Silver Medal winner Nishad Kumar has been honored by the Arjuna award from President Ram Nath Kovind. Nishad is an alumni of Saraswati Vidya Mandir, Katohar Khurd, HP, run by Himachal Shiksha Samiti. He had won a Gold medal in the high jump at Vidya Bharati's State and Kshetra level.

People Jubilant After Olympian Nishad Kumar Receives Arjun Award From President Of India. Nishad's mother Pushpa Devi was also present on this Award presentation occasion. This son of village Budaun Amb of sub-division Amb, secured first position in the state in the general category in high jump. Later in 2017 he went for training at Tau Devilal Sports Complex in Panchkula with Rs 2500 from



his parents. Here the coach, Naseem Ahmed, seeing his ability and dedication, provided him a room in the complex itself and also started giving him three thousand rupees a month on his behalf.

For this, his father worked hard to grow vegetables and his mother also reared cattle and sold milk. Nishad started to receive coaching from 2019 under the supervision of coach Satyanarayana at the National Camp in Bengaluru. He holds the national record in para athletics with a high jump of 2.06 meters. In 2019, the Para World Grand Six tournament was held in Dubai in which players from 152 countries participated. There Nishad had brought laurels to the country by winning a bronze medal. In Dubai itself, in 2021, he set a new Asian record in high jump.

Nishad took India to the victory podium in the Para Olympics with a silver medal. In the world-class competition, Nishad Kumar of Amb (Himachal Pradesh), won the silver medal in the Tokyo Para Olympic match in the high jump for India. Nishad won the medal for India by repeating his best performance of 2.06. Nishad Kumar and Delles Vice of USA took joint second place with a high jump of 2.06 metres. 2015, 2017 and 2019 world champion and Olympic champion Roderick Toussaint won the gold medal with a jump of 2.15m, setting a new world record.

"Inauguration Program Of The Newly Constructed Computer Lab"



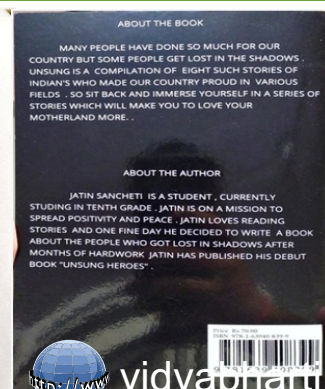
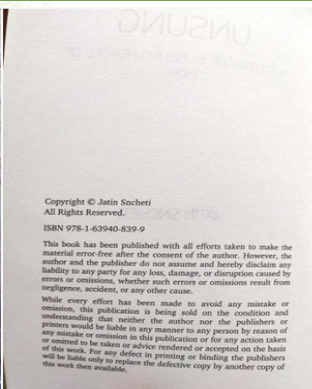
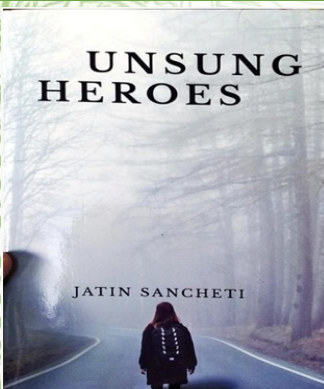

Providing Unhindered Education To The Residents Of Hilly Areas Of Arunachal For More Than Two Decades - Abotani Vidya Niketan, Pachin Colony



Established in the year 1994, Abotani Vidya Niketan, Pachin Colony has developed into one of the leading institutions in Papumpare district of Arunachal.

The School stands on 3 acres of land, located against a tranquil green backdrop. The campus consists of its own school

building, play ground, computer lab, well stocked library and science labs. The school also runs school buses for safe and easy transportation of students.

The school had a humble beginning in a rented place with very few students in the main town area. It was in the year 1998 that the school received the present land through a donation. Earlier the school had a 'Kuccha' structure and it was only in the



year 2018 that construction of the 'Pucca' structure was started. Presently a double storeyed building has been constructed along with attached hostel facilities. It is the only school in the state that received a 1 lakh ltr. overhead water tank for the use of the students and hostel residents.

More than 300 students from remote areas of the state, study in the school under the guidance of 24 teachers and have classes till the 10th standard.

Like all Vidya Bharati schools, Abotani Vidya Niketan lays great importance on the overall growth of the students. Thus personality development, physical education, yoga, cultural education, arts, moral education, social service, nationalism and spiritual education are all part of the curriculum. Students are encouraged to participate in sports and cultural

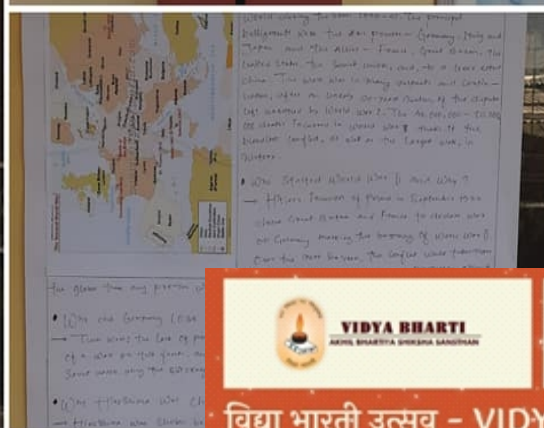
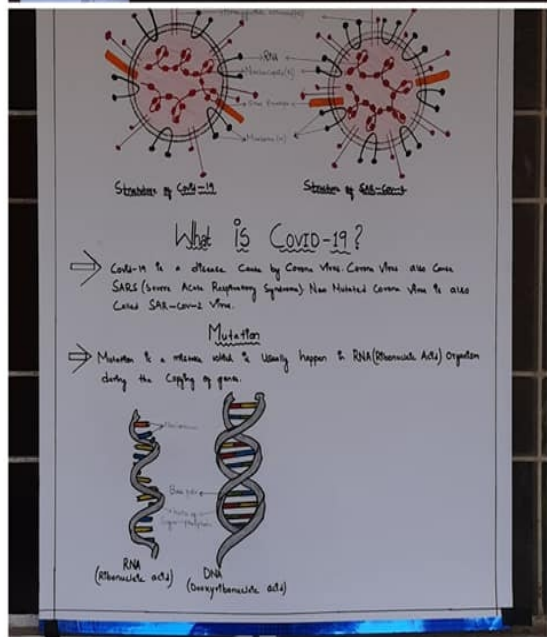
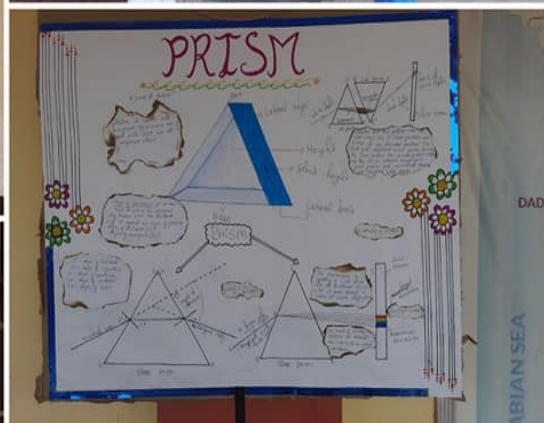


festivities with equal fervour.

In 2019, the student band from this school had participated in the State organised parade on the occasion of republic day and was awarded with 1st prize.

The children learn discipline, social service and the Indian culture through first hand experiences. Sometime back the school had organised one of the first 'Matra Sammelan', where 1200 mothers from the neighbouring areas attended the event. The Honorable Education Minister attended the event as well.

The essence of samaj seva or social service is one of the important components that is installed among the students. The school which believes in leading by example, is associated with diverse social activities. During the Covid



Pandemic, the school prepared and distributed more than 750 Khadi face masks. They also distributed 332 food kits to the needy. 1 lakh rupees was donated by the school members towards the CM relief fund.

Along with all the extracurricular activities, quality education is also provided by the school which is exemplified by several of its alumni who have become well settled in life. Several doctors, engineers, medical officers have received their education from Abotani Vidya Niketan.

While speaking about the support that the school received from the local community, principal of the school, Sukumaran Ji stated that they have received great support from the parents of the students, who feel that their children can grow into ideal and socially responsible citizens only under the guidance of the school.

Inspirational Story Of Alumni Priyanka Jain, Founder Of Darpan Roti Bank



In a time when the majority of the youths are still struggling to find a purpose in life and make a mark of themselves, few through their hard work and noble thoughts become an inspirational figure themselves. One such young woman and Vidya Bharati alumni is Priyanka Jain, who single handedly founded the NGO 'Darpan Roti Bank' in Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh to feed thousands of people in need. In a recent interview with Vidya Bharati Purv Chatra Parishad, Portal team, Priyanka, shared her story.

Priyanka Jain is an alumni of Saraswati Shishu Mandir, Uda Tehsil-Patan Jabalpur and then studied under several educational institutions to complete her schooling. She did her graduation and post graduation in B.Com and M.Com respectively.

After completion of her education, Priyanka founded the 'Darpan Roti Bank' in the year 2017 in order to feed hundreds of underprivileged and street dwellers. In a short span of a few years, Priyanka's hard work and zeal for social work has helped it to set up many new branches, across the city with volunteers pitching in to help her in her noble work.

Under this organisation, volunteers collect fresh home cooked rotis, which are then packed with other food and distributed across the city to people in need. The organisation, although started with the aim of providing food, has not limited its scope to only one kind of activity. It also works towards educating children belonging to families from slums and street dwellers.

Children from such families are often forced to beg in the streets and are occupied in physical labour. In order to save them from such a life, the organisation helps them to be occupied in creative pursuits like diya making during festival season or making safe colours during holi which generates revenue for their families. The volunteers also take steps to educate them, so that when they grow up, they can find more gainful employment.

Apart from this, frequent blood donation camps are also organised by Priyanka's organisation. During the recent Covid work the members had actively worked to supply masks, clothes, food and baby milk to those in need. They have also volunteered in hospitals and vaccination centers to lend a helping hand to health workers. Street plays and videos were also made to generate public awareness regarding the pandemic.

The single minded dedication of Priyanka to work for the betterment of the society has earned her several awards and accolades.

When asked about her inspiration behind her work, Priyanka stated that Social media and the childhood lessons learnt at school have motivated to work in this sector. She feels immensely satisfied when through her work she brings positive changes in the lives of others.

Priyanka always had the grit and determination to do something good for deprived people.





While speaking about her experience under Vidya Bharati, Priyanka stated that the 'Sanskars' and moral lessons that she had received from her teachers have guided her actions throughout her life and for which she is extremely grateful. She also urged all Vidya Bharati students to always keep their aim high in life and have faith in their own abilities.

Vaibhav Jindal explained in detail the various steps of his success for the brothers/sisters currently studying in the school.



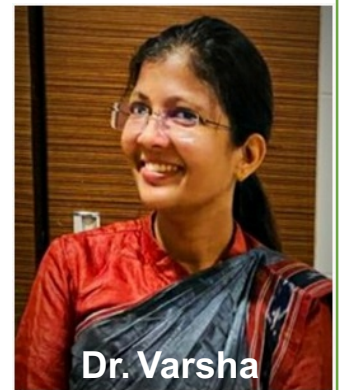

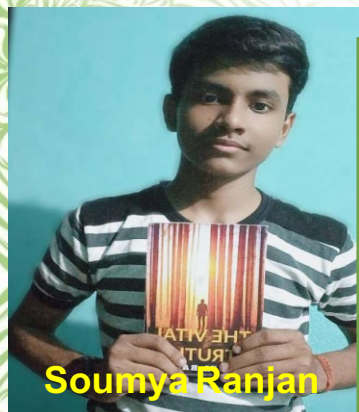

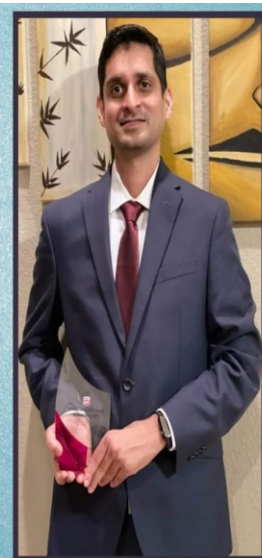
